- (4) <u>EVALUATE THE CREDENTIALS OF APPLICANTS AND RECOMMEND TO</u> THE BOARD CERTIFICATION OF APPLICANTS WHO FULFILL THE REQUIREMENTS FOR A CERTIFICATE TO PRACTICE MASSAGE THERAPY;
- (5) CONSIDER COMPLAINTS BROUGHT TO THE BOARD INVOLVING CERTIFIED MASSAGE THERAPISTS AND RECOMMEND TO THE BOARD THE APPROPRIATE DISCIPLINARY ACTION;
- (6) EVALUATE EDUCATION PROGRAMS IN MASSAGE THERAPY FOR APPROVAL BY THE BOARD;
 - (7) KEEP A RECORD OF ITS PROCEEDINGS; AND
 - (8) SUBMIT AN ANNUAL REPORT TO THE BOARD.

- (II) AN INDIVIDUAL PERMITTED TO PRACTICE MASSAGE THERAPY UNDER REGULATIONS ADOPTED BY THE BOARD, IF THE INDIVIDUAL:
- <u>1. OTHERWISE HAS QUALIFIED TO PRACTICE MASSAGE</u> THERAPY IN ANY OTHER STATE OR COUNTRY THAT HAS SUBSTANTIALLY SIMILAR REQUIREMENTS FOR AUTHORIZATION TO PRACTICE MASSAGE THERAPY AND THE INDIVIDUAL IS IN THIS STATE FOR NO MORE THAN 7 DAYS; OR
