In accordance with Article II, Section 17 of the Maryland Constitution, I have today vetoed House Bill 465.

This bill extends the State Board of Cosmetologists by changing the sunset date from July 1, 1996 to July 1, 1998.

Senate Bill 350, which was passed by the General Assembly and signed by me on May 14, 1996, accomplishes the same purpose. Therefore, it is not necessary for me to sign House Bill 465.
