SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

**Article - Business Occupations and Professions**

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect ~~October~~ July 1, 1996.

In accordance with Article II, Section 17 of the Maryland Constitution, I have today vetoed House Bill 485.

This bill repeals the prohibition on the sale or disposal of game bird or mammal that is not permitted to be hunted or trapped in the State by a taxidermist or fur tanner licensee.
