

[(2)](3) The containers may be returned and at the time of refill shall be sealed by the pub-brewery licensee.

[(3)](4) A holder of a Class 6 pub-brewery license ~~in the City of Annapolis, Anne Arundel County, Baltimore City, Baltimore County, or Charles County,~~ may not sell malt beverages to any retail alcoholic beverages licensee in this State for the purpose of a subsequent sale or distribution of that malt beverage under the retail license.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 1996.

Dear Mr. Speaker:

In accordance with Article II, Section 17 of the Maryland Constitution, I have today vetoed House Bill 1300.

This bill allows the Clerk of the Circuit Court for Harford County to record an instrument changing ownership of property if the County Treasurer endorses the instrument and is accompanied by a complete State intake sheet and any survey. Transfer of ownership shall be effective as of the recordation date.

Senate Bill 672, which was passed by the General Assembly and signed by me on May 14, 1996, accomplishes the same purpose. Therefore, it is not necessary for me to sign House Bill 1300.

AN ACT concerning

Real Property - Harford County - Recordation
