RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BOWIE, MARYLAND ENLARGING THE CORPORATE BOUNDARIES OF THE CITY OF BOWIE BY ANNEXING LAND CONTIGUOUS TO AND ADJOINING THE EXISTING CORPORATE AREA OF THE CITY OF BOWIE LOCATED EAST OF MARYLAND ROUTE 197 AND DIRECTLY NORTH OF AND ADJACENT TO THE SUBDIVISION KNOWN AS ROCKLEGE AT BELAIR, DUE NORTH OF THE INTERSECTION OF RUSTIC HILL DRIVE AND ROCHESTER LANE AND CONSISTING OF 9.63 ACRES, MORE OR LESS, AND MORE COMMONLY KNOWN AS 5004 ROCHESTER LANE, BOWIE, MARYLAND SUBJECT TO THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS CONTAINED IN THAT CERTAIN ANNEXATION AGREEMENT BY AND BETWEEN THE CITY OF BOWIE AND JAMES R.
