- (3) May lose the loan, grant or assistance if the development is delayed.

Bill No. 21–1995

An Act repealing and re-enacting Section 1.400 "Employee Pensions" of Subtitle 4 "Retirement Plan" of Title 1 "Personnel Administration" of the Howard County Code to establish a Howard County Retirement Plan and the terms of this Plan; to establish a Pension Oversight Commission made up of County citizens; and generally relating to retirement plans; including renumbering Section 1.401 "Police and Fire Pension Plan" and deleting language regarding incentives for retirement in 1992; and renumbering, but not otherwise changing Section 1.402 "Length of service award program for volunteer firefighting/EMS personnel" of the Howard County Code; exempting the Retirement Plan from the provisions of the Purchasing Code; and requiring members of the Pension Oversight Commission to file financial disclosure with the Ethics Commission.
