20-513. ACTIONS AGAINST PRODUCERS.

THE FUND MAY REFUSE TO ACCEPT FURTHER APPLICATIONS FROM A PRODUCER OR MAY TERMINATE THE AUTHORITY OF THE PRODUCER TO BIND COVERAGE OR BOTH IF:

- (1) THE FUND FINDS THAT THE PRODUCER HAS ENGAGED IN THE PRACTICE OF BINDING COVERAGE IN THE FUND IN VIOLATION OF REGULATIONS ADOPTED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES; OR
- (2) AFTER DEMAND HAS BEEN MADE BY THE FUND, THE PRODUCER FAILS TO PAY MONEY OWED THE FUND AS A RESULT OF:
 - (I) THE BINDING OR CHANGE OF COVERAGE; OR
- (II) A COMMISSION PAID TO THE PRODUCER ON A POLICY THAT IS CANCELED AFTER THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF COVERAGE.

20-514. NOTICE AND HEARING.

(A) REQUIRED.
