(A) Without regard to which fiscal year in which the expenditures occur, no more than \$70.5 million in funds from the Transportation Trust Fund or any other State source, may be expended for the construction of State or County roadways or grants pertaining to the infrastructure required as a result of the proposed Redskins Stadium on the Wilson Farm Property in Prince George's County. The \$70.5 million may be directly expended or provided by the Secretary as a grant or grants to (1) Prince George's County or (2) Jack Kent Cooke, Inc. (JKCI), JKC Stadium, Inc. (JKCS), or (3) JKCI's or JKCS's contractors or subcontractors as
