

Further provided that ~~\$5,000,000~~ \$7,000,000 of this appropriation, made for the purpose of funding the Community Revitalization projects may only be used to fund improvements which have a direct transportation purpose. Funds may not be used to design or construct water or sewer lines, tourist facilities, non-normal landscaping, or streetscape improvements not relating to a transportation function.

Further provided that the Department of Transportation shall jointly develop and select transportation related projects in coordination with the community revitalization programs operated by the Departments of Housing and Community Development (DHCD) and Business and Economic Development (DBED). A report which lists the projects and areas targeted for funding, and discusses the efforts to coordinate with the programs in DHCD and DBED should be submitted to the budget committees on December 1, 1996 for review and comment
