

(c) ["Police officer" means a person who has the authority to enforce the general criminal laws of this State and is a member of any of the following law enforcement units:]

(1) The Deputy Secretary of Public Safety and Correctional Services or the Deputy Secretary's representative, shall be chairman of the Commission. The Commission, at its initial organization meeting to be held promptly after the appointment and qualifications of its members, and thereafter annually shall elect a vice-chairman from among its members, and shall meet at such other times within the State of Maryland as it or its chairman may determine. A majority of the Commission shall constitute a quorum for the transaction of any business, the performance of any duty, or for the exercise of any of its authority.

(2) The Commission shall:

(i) Maintain minutes of its meetings and such other records as it deems necessary; and

(ii) Upon request, provide information regarding the budget, activities, and programs of the Commission.

(3) The members of the Commission shall receive no salary but all members shall be reimbursed in accordance with the Standard State Travel Regulations for their expenses lawfully incurred in the performance of their official functions.
