SUBTITLE 4. ELIGIBILITY FOR COVERAGE; CONTINUATION AND CONVERSION OF POLICIES.

15-401. COVERAGE FOR NEWLY BORN OR NEWLY ADOPTED CHILDREN OR GRANDCHILDREN.

(A) "DATE OF ADOPTION" DEFINED.

IN THIS SECTION, "DATE OF ADOPTION" MEANS THE EARLIER OF:

- (1) A JUDICIAL DECREE OF ADOPTION; OR
- (2) THE ASSUMPTION OF CUSTODY, PENDING ADOPTION, OF A PROSPECTIVE ADOPTIVE CHILD BY A PROSPECTIVE ADOPTIVE PARENT.
 - (B) BENEFITS PAYABLE FROM MOMENT OF BIRTH OR DATE OF ADOPTION.
 - (1) THIS SUBSECTION APPLIES TO:
 - (I) EACH INDIVIDUAL HEALTH INSURANCE POLICY THAT:
- IS DELIVERED, ISSUED FOR DELIVERY, OR RENEWED IN THE STATE;
 - 2. PROVIDES COVERAGE ON AN EXPENSE-INCURRED BASIS;

INSURED:

AND

- 3. PROVIDES COVERAGE FOR A FAMILY MEMBER OF THE
- (II) EACH GROUP HEALTH INSURANCE POLICY, INCLUDING A CONTRACT ISSUED BY A NONPROFIT HEALTH SERVICE PLAN, THAT:
- 1. IS DELIVERED, ISSUED FOR DELIVERY, OR RENEWED IN THE STATE:
- 2. PROVIDES COVERAGE ON AN EXPENSE-INCURRED BASIS FOR EMPLOYEES OF AN EMPLOYER OR EMPLOYERS OR MEMBERS OF A UNION OR UNIONS; AND
- 3. PROVIDES COVERAGE FOR A FAMILY MEMBER OF A COVERED EMPLOYEE OR MEMBER; AND
 - (III) EACH INDIVIDUAL SERVICE OR INDEMNITY CONTRACT THAT:
- 1. IS DELIVERED, ISSUED FOR DELIVERY, OR RENEWED IN THE STATE BY A NONPROFIT HEALTH SERVICE PLAN; AND
- 2. PROVIDES COVERAGE FOR A FAMILY MEMBER OF THE SUBSCRIBER.
- (2) EACH POLICY OR CONTRACT SUBJECT TO THIS SUBSECTION SHALL PROVIDE THAT THE HEALTH INSURANCE BENEFITS APPLICABLE FOR CHILDREN OR GRANDCHILDREN SHALL BE PAYABLE FOR A NEWLY BORN OR NEWLY ADOPTED
