the proposed Fiscal Year 1998 budget as contained within the final 1997 Consolidated Transportation Program (CTP). The reduction of \$18,162,254 consists of \$862,254 made by the General Assembly during the 1997 session and an additional \$17,300,000 in project cash flow deferrals which will be identified by the MDOT. Provided, however, that this ceiling may be increased only under the following conditions:

- (1) Due to shifts in project cash flow from Fiscal Year 1997; or
- (2) Due to unforescen circumstances, such as market opportunities, which require immediate action by the State; and
- (3) The budget committees are notified of the proposed increase in special fund expenditures for capital purposes, and are provided 30 days to review and comment upon the proposed increase.
- A report identifying the projects included in the \$17.3 million capital reduction and the level of turnover expectancy reductions in each modal administration should be submitted to the budget committees by August 1, 1997.
