Further provided that \$1,500,000 of this appropriation, made for the purpose of funding transportation control measures (TCMs) in the Washington metropolitan region, (TCMs) may not be expended until:

(1) The Maryland Department of Transportation (MDOT) has modeled the Consolidated Transportation Program (CTP) for compliance with the State's air quality implementation plan and determined the level of emissions reductions necessary to be achieved through implementation of TCMs;

(2) MDOT submits a list of the specific TCMs proposed for funding by July 15, 1997; and

(3) The budget committees review and comment upon the list of proposed TCMs or 45 days elapse from the date of receipt by the committees
