

(V) REPORT ON BENEFITS AND COSTS OF THE MANDATED HEALTH INSURANCE BENEFIT, NONDISCRIMINATION PROVISION, OR BENEFICIARY OR LENGTH OF COVERAGE PROVISION INCLUDING, IF SUFFICIENT INFORMATION IS AVAILABLE, THE IMPACT ON:

1. PREMIUMS IN THE STATE; AND

2. UTILIZATION OF THE MANDATED HEALTH INSURANCE BENEFIT, NONDISCRIMINATION PROVISION, OR BENEFICIARY OR LENGTH OF COVERAGE PROVISION AND RELATED SERVICES;

(VI) REPORT ON THE SCOPE AND APPLICATION OF THE MANDATED HEALTH INSURANCE BENEFIT, NONDISCRIMINATION PROVISION, OR BENEFICIARY OR LENGTH OF COVERAGE PROVISION;

(VII) REPORT ON THE EFFECT OF THE MANDATED HEALTH INSURANCE BENEFIT, NONDISCRIMINATION PROVISION, OR BENEFICIARY OR LENGTH OF COVERAGE PROVISION ON A BENEFIT PACKAGE PROVIDED BY AN EMPLOYER; AND

(VIII) MAKE ANY OTHER FINDINGS THAT THE PANEL CONSIDERS APPROPRIATE.

(3) THE PANEL MAY:

(I) SOLICIT ADDITIONAL INFORMATION THAT ADDRESSES A PARTICULAR CRITERION; AND

(II) HOLD PUBLIC HEARINGS ON EACH SUBJECT UNDER REVIEW.

(C) SUBMISSION OF INFORMATION TO PANEL.

A PERSON MAY SUBMIT TO AN EXPERT REVIEW PANEL INFORMATION ABOUT A MATTER REFERRED TO IN SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION THAT RELATES TO A MANDATED HEALTH INSURANCE BENEFIT, NONDISCRIMINATION PROVISION, OR BENEFICIARY OR LENGTH OF COVERAGE PROVISION UNDER REVIEW BY THE PANEL.

(D) REPORT; ACTION BY COMMITTEE.

(1) EACH EXPERT REVIEW PANEL SHALL TRANSMIT ITS REPORT TO THE COMMITTEE ON OR BEFORE OCTOBER 31.

(2) THE COMMITTEE MAY:

(I) IDENTIFY ANY AREAS IN WHICH THE REPORT DOES NOT COMPLY WITH THIS SUBTITLE; AND

(II) RETURN THE REPORT TO THE PANEL FOR RECONSIDERATION OF THOSE AREAS.
