27-402. SCOPE OF SUBTITLE.

THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SUBTITLE THAT APPLY TO INSURERS ALSO APPLY TO:

- (1) A CORPORATION THAT OPERATES A NONPROFIT HEALTH SERVICE PLAN UNDER TITLE 14, SUBTITLE 2 OF THIS ARTICLE;
- (2) A DENTAL PLAN ORGANIZATION AS DEFINED IN § 14-401 OF THIS ARTICLE;
- (3) A HEALTH MAINTENANCE ORGANIZATION AS DEFINED IN TITLE 19, SUBTITLE 7 OF THE HEALTH - GENERAL ARTICLE;
- (4) A SURPLUS LINES INSURER;
- (5) THE MARYLAND AUTOMOBILE INSURANCE FUND;
- (6) THE INJURED WORKERS' INSURANCE FUND;
- (7) THE STATE WHEN A CLAIM HAS BEEN FILED AGAINST THE STATE UNDER TITLE 12 OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE;
- (8) THE STATE WHEN A CLAIM HAS BEEN FILED AGAINST THE STATE UNDER TITLE 8, SUBTITLE 1 OF THE STATE PERSONNEL AND PENSIONS ARTICLE;
- (9) THE STATE WHEN A CLAIM HAS BEEN FILED AGAINST THE STATE UNDER TITLE 9 OF THE LABOR AND EMPLOYMENT ARTICLE;
- (10) THE MASS TRANSIT ADMINISTRATION WHEN ACTING AS A SELF-INSURER UNDER § 7-703 OF THE TRANSPORTATION ARTICLE;
- (11) A THIRD PARTY ADMINISTRATOR UNDER TITLE 8, SUBTITLE 3 OF THIS ARTICLE; AND
- (12) AN AGENT, EMPLOYEE, OR REPRESENTATIVE OF AN ENTITY DESCRIBED IN ITEMS (1) THROUGH (11) OF THIS SECTION.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This section is new language derived without substantive change from former Art. 48A, § 233(a)(3).

Although former Art. 48A, § 233(a)(3) was a definition of "[i]nsurer", it served only to delimit the scope of this subtitle. It is revised to clarify that function. No substantive change is intended.

In item (11) of this section, the reference to a third party administrator "under Title 8, Subtitle 3 of this article" is substituted for the former reference to a third party administrator "as defined under Subtitle 54 of this article" to reflect that the term "third party administrator" was not defined in former Subtitle 54 - now Title 8, Subtitle 3 of this article - but that the entity was regulated "under" those provisions.
