SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

(f) (2) As directed by the Commissioner, the investigators shall investigate, in the State, violations or alleged violations of this article, including [§ X-XXX] INSURANCE FRAUD AS DEFINED IN § 27-801 of this article.

(a) Fees for the following certificates, licenses, and services shall be collected in advance by the Commissioner, and shall be paid by the appropriate persons to the Commissioner:
