(E) A PERSON WHO VIOLATES ANY PROVISION OF THIS SECTION IS GUILTY OF A MISDEMEANOR AND <u>ON CONVICTION</u> IS SUBJECT TO A FINE NOT TO EXCEED \$500 FOR EACH VIOLATION.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1997.
