- [(k)](L) (M) (1) "Personal care" means a service that an individual normally would perform personally, but for which the individual needs help from another because of advanced age, infirmity, or physical or mental limitation.
  - (2) "Personal care" includes:
    - (i) Help in walking;
    - (ii) Help in getting in and out of bed;
    - (iii) Help in bathing;
    - (iv) Help in dressing;
    - (v) Help in feeding; and
    - (vi) General supervision and help in daily living.
- [(1)] (M) (N) (1) "Related institution" means an organized institution, environment, or home that:
- (i) Maintains conditions or facilities and equipment to provide domiciliary, personal, or nursing care for 2 or more unrelated individuals who are dependent on the administrator, operator, or proprietor for nursing care or the subsistence of daily living in a safe, sanitary, and healthful environment; and
  - (ii) Admits or retains the individuals for overnight care.
- (2) "Related institution" does not include a nursing facility or visiting nurse service that is conducted only by or for adherents of a bona fide church or religious organization, in accordance with tenets and practices that include reliance on treatment by spiritual means alone for healing.
- (N) "RESIDENTIAL TREATMENT CENTER" MEANS A RELATED INSTITUTION THAT PROVIDES INPATIENT TREATMENT FOR EMOTIONALLY DISTURBED CHILDREN OR ADOLESCENTS WITH OVERNIGHT ACCOMMODATIONS FOR TWO OR MORE NONRELATED INDIVIDUALS WHO ARE REFERRED FOR ADMISSION ON THE RECOMMENDATION OF A PHYSICIAN.
- (O) "RESIDENTIAL TREATMENT CENTER" MEANS A PSYCHIATRIC INSTITUTION THAT PROVIDES CAMPUS-BASED INTENSIVE AND EXTENSIVE EVALUATION AND TREATMENT OF CHILDREN AND ADOLESCENTS WITH SEVERE AND CHRONIC EMOTIONAL DISTURBANCES WHO REQUIRE A SELF-CONTAINED THERAPEUTIC, EDUCATIONAL, AND RECREATIONAL PROGRAM IN A RESIDENTIAL SETTING.
  - [(m)] (O) (P) "Unrelated individual" means anyone who is not:
- (1) A child, grandchild, parent, grandparent, sibling, stepparent, stepchild, or spouse of the proprietor; or
  - (2) An in-law of any of these individuals.
