

CHAPTER 162

(Senate Bill 334)

AN ACT concerning

**Baltimore City Deputy Sheriffs—Pensions and Retirement
Law Enforcement Officers' Pension System - Membership**

FOR the purpose of authorizing certain Baltimore City Deputy Sheriffs to become members of the Law Enforcement Officers' Pension System; providing for certain exceptions; requiring individuals for whom membership in the Law Enforcement Officers' Pension System is optional to apply for membership on or before a certain date; prohibiting those individuals from electing membership on or after a certain date; and generally relating to membership of ~~Baltimore City Deputy Sheriffs~~ in the Law Enforcement Officers' Pension System.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - State Personnel and Pensions

26-201.

This (A) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION, THIS subtitle applies only to:

(1) an employee of the Department of Natural Resources commissioned by the Secretary of Natural Resources as:

(i) a Natural Resources police officer; or

(ii) a law enforcement officer, other than a Natural Resources police officer; [or]

(2) a law enforcement officer employed by the Maryland Investigative Services Unit; OR
