

**CHAPTER 174**

**(Senate Bill 409)**

AN ACT concerning

**Vehicle Laws - Assurance Fund**

FOR the purpose of ~~abolishing the Motor Vehicle Administration's Assurance Fund; requiring the Administration to ensure that certain security interests are properly filed, recorded, and indexed; repealing certain provisions relating to certain claims for payment from the Assurance Fund; altering provisions relating to the distribution of certain filing fees; providing for the transfer of certain funds remaining in the Assurance Fund on the effective date of this Act~~ establishing a limit on certain payments made from the Motor Vehicle Administration's Assurance Fund; prohibiting recovery for a single claim from both the Assurance Fund and the State Insurance Trust Fund; providing for the handling of certain claims; and generally relating to security interests in vehicles and the Assurance Fund.
