- (B) THE MEMBERSHIP OF THE ADVISORY COMMITTEE SHALL INCLUDE TWO NURSING ASSISTANTS.
- (C) THE ADVISORY COMMITTEE SHALL-ADVISE THE BOARD CONCERNING MATTERS RELATED TO NURSING ASSISTANTS.

8-6A-15.

- (A) THE BOARD SHALL APPROVE EACH NURSING ASSISTANT TRAINING PROGRAM PRIOR TO ITS IMPLEMENTATION AND PROVIDE PERIODIC SURVEY OF ALL PROGRAMS IN THE STATE:
- (B) THE CURRICULUM CONTENT FOR AN APPROVED NURSING ASSISTANT TRAINING PROGRAM SHALL COMPLY WITH THE REGULATIONS ADOPTED BY THE BOARD:
- (C) THE CURRICULUM-SHALL INCLUDE-MATERIAL THAT-PROVIDES A BASIC LEVEL OF KNOWLEDGE AND DEMONSTRABLE SKILLS FOR EACH INDIVIDUAL COMPLETING THE PROGRAM AND BE PRESENTED IN A MANNER THAT PROVIDES FOR CONSIDERATION OF INDIVIDUALS WITH LIMITED LITERACY SKILLS.
- (D) THE CURRICULUM SHALL ALLOW FOR INDIVIDUAL CONTENT RELATED TO THE NEEDS OF POPULATIONS IN SPECIFIC HEALTH CARE SETTINGS.
- (E) THE BOARD MAY NOT REQUIRE THE CURRICULUM CONTENT OF AN APPROVED NURSING ASSISTANT TRAINING PROGRAM TO SUBSTANTIALLY EXCEED THE REQUIREMENTS ESTABLISHED IN THE FEDERAL OMNIBUS BUDGET RECONCILIATION ACT OF 1987, AS AMENDED.

8-6A-16.

- (A) IF, DURING THE INVESTIGATION OF AN ALLEGATION BROUGHT AGAINST A-CERTIFIED NURSING ASSISTANT UNDER THIS SUBTITLE, THE BOARD HAS REASON TO BELIEVE THAT THE CERTIFIED NURSING ASSISTANT MAY CAUSE HARM TO A PERSON AFFECTED BY THE PRACTICE OF THE CERTIFIED NURSING ASSISTANT, THE BOARD, ON ITS OWN INITIATIVE, SHALL DIRECT THE CERTIFIED NURSING ASSISTANT TO SUBMIT TO AN APPROPRIATE EXAMINATION BY A HEALTH-CARE PROVIDER DESIGNATED BY THE BOARD.
- (B) IN RETURN FOR THE PRIVILEGE GIVEN TO A CERTIFIED NURSING ASSISTANT TO PRACTICE IN THE STATE, THE CERTIFIED NURSING ASSISTANT IS DEEMED TO HAVE:
- (1) CONSENTED TO SUBMIT TO AN EXAMINATION UNDER THIS SECTION IF REQUESTED BY THE BOARD IN WRITING; AND
- (2) WAIVED ANY LEGAL CLAIM OF PRIVILEGE AS TO THE TESTIMONY OR EXAMINATION REPORTS OF THE EXAMINING HEALTH CARE PROVIDER.
- (C) THE FAILURE OR REFUSAL OF A CERTIFIED NURSING ASSISTANT TO SUBMIT TO AN EXAMINATION REQUIRED UNDER SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION IS PRIMA FACIE EVIDENCE OF THE INABILITY OF THE CERTIFIED NURSING ASSISTANT TO COMPETENTLY PRACTICE AS A CERTIFIED NURSING ASSISTANT,
