- (I) <u>MEDICAL SERVICES PROVIDED PREHOSPITAL TO PREVENT IMMINENT DEATH OR AGGRAVATION OF ILLNESS OR INJURY WHETHER OR NOT TRANSPORT TO A HOSPITAL OR APPROPRIATE FACILITY OCCURS;</u>
- (II) TRANSPORT FROM THE SCENE OF A MEDICAL EMERGENCY TO A HOSPITAL OR APPROPRIATE FACILITY WHETHER OR NOT MEDICAL SERVICES ARE PROVIDED:
- (III) <u>MEDICAL INTERFACILITY TRANSPORT SERVICES TO AN APPROPRIATE FACILITY; OR</u>
- (IV) MEDICAL INTERFACILITY CRITICAL CARE TRANSPORT TO AN APPROPRIATE FACILITY.
- (6) "EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES PROVIDER" MEANS AN INDIVIDUAL LICENSED OR CERTIFIED BY THE EMS BOARD AS:
  - (I) A CARDIAC RESCUE TECHNICIAN;
  - (II) AN EMERGENCY MEDICAL DISPATCHER;
  - (III) AN EMERGENCY MEDICAL TECHNICIAN-AMBULANCE:
  - (IV) AN EMERGENCY MEDICAL TECHNICIAN-BASIC;
  - (V) AN EMERGENCY MEDICAL TECHNICIAN-PARAMEDIC; OR
  - (VI) A FIRST RESPONDER.
- (7) "EMERGENCY MEDICAL TECHNICIAN-AMBULANCE" (EMT-A) MEANS AN INDIVIDUAL WHO HAS:
- (I) COMPLETED AN EMERGENCY MEDICAL TECHNICIAN-AMBULANCE COURSE APPROVED BY THE EMS BOARD;
- (II) DEMONSTRATED COMPETENCE IN MEDICAL PROTOCOLS AS DETERMINED BY THE EMS BOARD; AND
- (III) BEEN EXAMINED BY THE EMS BOARD AND CERTIFIED AS AN EMT-A BY THE EMS BOARD.
- (8) "EMERGENCY MEDICAL TECHNICIAN-BASIC" (EMT-B) MEANS AN INDIVIDUAL WHO HAS:
- (I) COMPLETED AN EMERGENCY MEDICAL TECHNICIAN-BASIC COURSE APPROVED BY THE EMS BOARD;
- (II) DEMONSTRATED COMPETENCE IN MEDICAL PROTOCOLS AS DETERMINED BY THE EMS BOARD; AND
- (III) BEEN EXAMINED BY THE EMS BOARD AND CERTIFIED AS AN EMT-B BY THE EMS BOARD.
- (9) "EMERGENCY MEDICAL TECHNICIAN-PARAMEDIC" (EMT-P) MEANS AN INDIVIDUAL WHO HAS:
