- (I) COMPLETED AN EMERGENCY MEDICAL TECHNICIAN-PARAMEDIC COURSE APPROVED BY THE EMS BOARD;
- (II) BEEN TESTED AND REGISTERED BY THE NATIONAL REGISTRY OF EMERGENCY MEDICAL TECHNICIANS, INC. AS AN EMERGENCY MEDICAL TECHNICIAN-PARAMEDIC:
- (III) DEMONSTRATED COMPETENCE IN MEDICAL PROTOCOLS WITHIN THIS STATE AS DETERMINED BY THE EMS BOARD, AND
 - (IV) BEEN LICENSED AS AN EMT-P BY THE EMS BOARD.
 - (10) "FIRST RESPONDER" MEANS AN INDIVIDUAL WHO HAS:
- (I) COMPLETED A FIRST RESPONDER COURSE APPROVED BY THE EMS BOARD; AND
- (II) BEEN EXAMINED BY THE EMS BOARD AND CERTIFIED AS A FIRST RESPONDER BY THE EMS BOARD.
- (11) "LICENSE" MEANS A LICENSE ISSUED BY THE EMS BOARD TO PROVIDE EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES IN THE STATE, UNLESS THE CONTEXT REQUIRES OTHERWISE.
- (12) (I) "MEDICAL DIRECTION" MEANS THE WRITTEN OR ORAL INSTRUCTION BY A PHYSICIAN LICENSED TO PERFORM SPECIFIED MEDICAL PROCEDURES OR ADMINISTER SPECIFIED MEDICATIONS OR INTRAVENOUS SOLUTIONS.
- (II) "MEDICAL DIRECTION" INCLUDES THE ACTIVITIES OF A PHYSICIAN LICENSED PHYSICIAN IN THE STATE SERVING AS A MEDICAL DIRECTOR FOR AN AGENCY PROVIDING EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES INCLUDING QUALITY ASSURANCE, PLANNING, AND EDUCATION.
- (13) "NATIONAL REGISTRY" MEANS THE NONPROPRIETARY, NONGOVERNMENTAL AGENCY THAT PROVIDES STANDARDIZED NATIONAL TESTING AND REGISTRATION FOR EMERGENCY MEDICAL TECHNICIANS BASED ON NATIONAL TRAINING STANDARDS.
- (14) "PROVIDER REVIEW PANEL" MEANS THE TWELVE MEMBER 13-MEMBER PANEL APPOINTED BY THE EMS BOARD IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE PROVISIONS OF SUBSECTION (E) OF THIS SECTION.
- (B) (1) EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE PROVIDED IN THIS SECTION, AN INDIVIDUAL MAY NOT PROVIDE EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES IN THE STATE UNLESS ISSUED A LICENSE OR CERTIFICATE BY THE EMS BOARD UNDER THIS SECTION.
 - (2) THIS SECTION DOES NOT APPLY TO:
 - (I) AN INDIVIDUAL WHO:
