- (a) A person who willfully or knowingly violates this title is guilty of a misdemeanor and, on conviction, is subject to a fine not exceeding [\$5,000] \$10,000 or imprisonment not exceeding [1 year] 2 YEARS or both.
- (b) Each associate, employee, manager, or partner who participates in or consents to a violation of this title is guilty of a misdemeanor and, on conviction, is subject to a fine not exceeding \$5,000 or imprisonment not exceeding 1 year or both.
 - (c) Each violation of this title is a separate offense.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That § 12-209(a)(2)(vi) of the Business Regulation Article, as enacted by this Act, shall be construed only prospectively and may not be applied or interpreted to have any effect on or application to licensees or license applicants for employees hired before the effective date of this Act.

SECTION 2. 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 1997.
