FOR the purpose of ~~requiring certain vacancies on the Prince George's County Board of Education to be filled by special election; requiring the candidate who receives the greatest number of votes to take office on a certain date; providing for a certain individual to fill the vacancy if no qualified individual files as a candidate; providing that an individual appointed by the County Executive of Prince George's County to fill a vacancy on the Prince George's County Board of Education serves until a successor is elected at the next congressional election; and generally relating to the Prince George's County Board.~~
