- (II) A CHILD WHO IS ALLEGED TO HAVE COMMITTED A DELINQUENT ACT.
  - {(2)}(3) "Victim" means a person who[:
    - (i) Has testified as a witness; and
- (ii) Is]- IS-the victim of a crime [of-violence under § 643B of this article or a crime involving, causing, or resulting in death or serious bodily-harm] OR DELINQUENT ACT for which the defendant is being tried.
  - [(3)](4) "Representative" means a person who is:
    - (i) {1. Subpoenaed or has testified; and
- 2.] Selected by the next of kin or guardian of a person who is deceased or disabled as a result of a crime [of violence under § 643B of this article or a crime involving, causing, or resulting in death or serious bodily harm]—OR DELINQUENT ACT; or
- (ii) Designated by the court in the event of a dispute over the representative.
- (5) "TRIAL" INCLUDES AN ADJUDICATORY HEARING AND ANY OTHER COURT-PROCEEDING IN WHICH THE DEFENDANT HAS A RIGHT TO APPEAR.
- (b) A victim or representative shall be presumed to have the right to be present [at] THROUGHOUT the trial.
- (e) The judge may sequester a victim or representative from any part of the trial at the request of the defendant or the State only after a finding of good cause.
- (d) A judge may remove a victim or representative from the trial for the same causes and in the same manner as the laws or rules of court provide for the exclusion or removal of the defendant.

- (a) In a case of abuse of a child as defined in § 5-701 of the Family Law Article or § 35C of this article, a court may order that the testimony of a child victim be taken outside the courtroom and shown in the courtroom by means of closed circuit television if:
  - (1) The testimony is taken during the proceeding; and
- (2) The judge determines that testimony by the child victim in the defendant's presence will result in the child suffering serious emotional distress such that the child cannot reasonably communicate.
- (b) (1) Only the following persons may be in the room with the child when the child testifies by closed circuit television:
  - (i) [The] ONE prosecuting attorney;
  - (ii) [The] ONE attorney for the defendant OR;
