- 2. TWO OR MORE MICROPHOTOGRAPHS;
- 3. TWO OR MORE ELECTRONIC IMAGES;
- 4. VIDEOTAPE; OR
- 5. ANY OTHER MEDIUM; AND
- (II) SHOWING THE REAR OF A MOTOR VEHICLE AND, ON AT LEAST ONE IMAGE OR PORTION OF TAPE, CLEARLY IDENTIFYING THE REGISTRATION PLATE NUMBER OF THE MOTOR VEHICLE.
- (5) "TRAFFIC CONTROL SIGNAL MONITORING SYSTEM" MEANS A DEVICE WITH ONE OR MORE MOTOR VEHICLE SENSORS WORKING IN CONJUNCTION WITH A TRAFFIC CONTROL SIGNAL TO PRODUCE RECORDED IMAGES OF MOTOR VEHICLES ENTERING AN INTERSECTION AGAINST A RED SIGNAL INDICATION.
- (B) THIS SECTION APPLIES TO A VIOLATION OF § 21–202(H) OF THIS SUBTITLE AT AN INTERSECTION MONITORED BY A TRAFFIC CONTROL SIGNAL MONITORING SYSTEM.
- (C) (I) UNLESS THE DRIVER OF THE MOTOR VEHICLE RECEIVED A CITATION FROM A POLICE OFFICER AT THE TIME OF THE VIOLATION, THE OWNER OR, IN ACCORDANCE WITH SUBSECTION (F)(S) OF THIS SECTION, THE DRIVER OF A MOTOR VEHICLE IS SUBJECT TO A CIVIL PENALTY IF THE MOTOR VEHICLE IS RECORDED BY A TRAFFIC CONTROL SIGNAL MONITORING SYSTEM WHILE BEING OPERATED IN VIOLATION OF § 21–202(H) OF THIS SUBTITLE.
 - (2) A CIVIL PENALTY UNDER THIS SUBSECTION MAY NOT EXCEED \$100.
- (3) FOR PURPOSES OF THIS SECTION, THE DISTRICT COURT SHALL PRESCRIBE:
- (I) A UNIFORM CITATION FORM CONSISTENT WITH SUBSECTION (D)(I) OF THIS SECTION AND § 7-302 OF THE COURTS AND JUDICIAL PROCEEDINGS ARTICLE; AND
- (II) A CIVIL PENALTY, WHICH SHALL BE INDICATED ON THE CITATION, TO BE PAID BY PERSONS WHO CHOOSE TO PREPAY THE CIVIL PENALTY WITHOUT APPEARING IN DISTRICT COURT.
- (D) (1) SUBJECT TO THE PROVISIONS OF PARAGRAPHS (2) THROUGH (4) OF THIS SUBSECTION, AN AGENCY SHALL MAIL TO THE OWNER LIABLE UNDER SUBSECTION (C) OF THIS SECTION A CITATION WHICH SHALL INCLUDE:
- (I) THE NAME AND ADDRESS OF THE REGISTERED OWNER OF THE VEHICLE:
- (II) THE REGISTRATION NUMBER OF THE MOTOR VEHICLE INVOLVED IN THE VIOLATION;
 - (III) THE VIOLATION CHARGED;
 - (IV) THE LOCATION OF THE INTERSECTION;
