

(II) FOR PURPOSES OF DETERMINING THE PERCENTAGE ALLOCATED UNDER THIS SUBSECTION TO EACH COUNTY, THE PROPERTY TAX ACCOUNTS OF EACH COUNTY THAT FAILS TO SATISFY THE REQUIREMENTS OF SUBSECTION (A) OR (B) OF THIS SECTION SHALL BE EXCLUDED FROM THE STATEWIDE TOTAL.

(3) EACH COUNTY SHALL DISTRIBUTE FUNDS PROVIDED UNDER THIS SUBSECTION IN ACCORDANCE WITH § 45(B) OF THIS SUBTITLE.

Chapter 424 of the Acts of 1996

[SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall remain effective until the end of June 30, 1997 and, at the end of June 30, 1997 with no further action required by the General Assembly, this Act shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.]

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1997 and shall be applicable to all fiscal years beginning on or after July 1, 1996.
