(Senate Bill 260)

AN ACT concerning

Motor Vehicle Administration - Access to Public Records

FOR the purpose of prohibiting the disclosure of Motor Vehicle Administration records containing certain personal information, unless the information is used by certain persons for certain purposes and under certain circumstances; requiring the Administration to disclose certain personal information under certain circumstances; prohibiting the person who receives personal information from using it in certain ways; requiring the Administration to provide certain notice to certain individuals under certain circumstances; authorizing certain individuals to prohibit the disclosure of certain personal information under certain circumstances; authorizing the Administration to disclose personal information under certain circumstances even if the individual has not received a certain notice from the
