CONSENT IS OBTAINED WITHIN THE 6-MONTH PERIOD BEFORE THE DATE OF THE REQUEST FOR PERSONAL INFORMATION; AND

(XII) FOR A USE SPECIFICALLY AUTHORIZED BY THE LAW OF THIS STATE, IF THE USE IS RELATED TO THE OPERATION OF A MOTOR VEHICLE OR PUBLIC SAFETY, AND

(XIII) FOR INCLUSION IN-LISTS OF INFORMATION TO BE USED FOR SURVEYS, MARKETING, AND SOLICITATIONS PROVIDED THAT:

- HEN THE INDIVIDUAL IS APPLYING FOR OR RENEWING A DRIVER'S LICENSE, CERTIFICATE OF TITLE, REGISTRATION, OR IDENTIFICATION CARD, THE CUSTODIAN NOTIFIES THE INDIVIDUAL, IN A CLEAR AND CONSPICUOUS MANNER, OF THE OPPORTUNITY TO PROHIBIT USE FOR THIS PURPOSE AND THE INDIVIDUAL HAS NOT-PROHIBITED USE FOR THIS PURPOSE:
- 2. THE PERSONAL INFORMATION IS USED SOLELY FOR SURVEYS, MARKETING, OR SOLICITATIONS AND IS NOT USED FOR A PURPOSE NOT APPROVED BY THE MOTOR VEHICLE ADMINISTRATION; AND
- 3. THE PERSONAL INFORMATION IS NOT USED FOR TELEPHONE SOLICITATION.
- (4) A CUSTODIAN DISCLOSING PERSONAL INFORMATION UNDER PARAGRAPH (3) OF THIS SUBSECTION:
- (I) SHALL LIMIT DISCLOSURE TO THE MINIMUM AMOUNT OF PERSONAL INFORMATION REQUIRED TO ACCOMPLISH THE PURPOSE FOR WHICH THE REQUEST IS MADE; AND
- (II) MAY NOT DISCLOSE INFORMATION CONCERNING THE PHYSICAL CHARACTERISTICS, MEDICAL CONDITION, OR DISABILITY OF AN INDIVIDUAL UNLESS THE CUSTODIAN DETERMINES THAT DISCLOSURE OF THE INFORMATION IS IN THE PUBLIC INTEREST AND WILL NOT UNDULY JEOPARDIZE THE PRIVACY OF THE INDIVIDUAL.
- (5) (6) (1) A PERSON RECEIVING PERSONAL INFORMATION UNDER PARAGRAPH (4) OR (5) OF THIS SUBSECTION MAY NOT USE OR REDISCLOSE THE PERSONAL INFORMATION FOR A PURPOSE OTHER THAN THE PURPOSE FOR WHICH THE CUSTODIAN DISCLOSED THE PERSONAL INFORMATION.
- (II) A PERSON RECEIVING PERSONAL INFORMATION UNDER PARAGRAPH (3) PARAGRAPH (4) OR (5) OF THIS SUBSECTION WHO REDISCLOSES THE PERSONAL INFORMATION SHALL:
- 1. KEEP A RECORD FOR 5 YEARS OF THE PERSON TO WHOM THE INFORMATION IS REDISCLOSED AND THE PURPOSE FOR WHICH THE INFORMATION IS TO BE USED; AND
- 2. MAKE THE RECORD AVAILABLE TO THE CUSTODIAN ON REQUEST.
