SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That Section 1 of this Act shall take effect October 1, 1997. Sections 16-110.1(d) and 16-110.3 of the Transportation Article, as enacted by Section 1 of this Act, shall remain effective for a period of 5 years and, at the end of September 30, 2002, with no further action required by the General Assembly, §§ 16-110.1(d) and 16-110.3 of the Transportation Article, as enacted by Section 1 of this Act shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.

SECTION 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That Section 2 of this Act shall take effect upon the abrogation of § 16–110.1(d) of the Transportation Article as enacted by Section 1 of this Act.
