- (iii) "That A-B on the day of, nineteen hundred and at the County (City) aforesaid, unlawfully, while under the influence of drugs, did kill C-D, against the peace, government, and dignity of the State."; or
- (iv) "That A-B on the day of, nineteen hundred and at the County (City) aforesaid, unlawfully, while under the influence of a controlled dangerous substance, did kill C-D, against the peace, government, and dignity of the State.".

Article - Courts and Judicial Proceedings

<u>4–301.</u>

- (b) Except as provided in § 4-302 OF THIS SUBTITLE, the District Court also has exclusive original jurisdiction in a criminal case in which a person at least 18 years old or a corporation is charged with:
- (1) Commission of a common-law or statutory misdemeanor regardless of the amount of money or value of the property involved;
- (2) <u>Violation of §§ 342 through 344 of Article 27 of the Code, whether a felony or a misdemeanor;</u>
- (3) <u>Violation of a county, municipal, or other ordinance, if the violation is not a felony:</u>
- (4) Criminal violation of a State, county, or municipal rule or regulation, if the violation is not a felony;
- (5) Doing or omitting to do any act made punishable by a fine, imprisonment, or other penalty as provided by the particular law, ordinance, rule, or regulation defining the violation is not a felony;
- (6) <u>Violation of Article 27, § 141 of this Code, whether a felony or a misdemeanor;</u>
- (7) <u>Violation of Article 27, § 145 of this Code, whether a felony or misdemeanor;</u>
 - (8) Violation of Article 27, § 44 of the Code;
- (9) Violation of Article 48A, § 233 of the Code, whether a felony or a misdemeanor;
 - (10) Violation of § 9–1106 of the Labor and Employment Article; [or]
 - (11) Violation of \$ 14-1403 of the Commercial Law Article;
 - (12) VIOLATION OF ARTICLE 27, § 388 OF THE CODE; OR
 - (13) VIOLATION OF ARTICLE 27, § 388A OF THE CODE.
