SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That Section(s) 12 of Article 49D - Office for Children, Youth, and Families of the Annotated Code of Maryland be transferred to be Section(s) 2-107 8-416 of Article - Education of the Annotated Code of Maryland.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 49D - Office for Children, Youth, and Families

- (d) The following units are in the Office:
 - (1) Advisory Committee for Children, Youth, and Families;
 - (2) Children's councils;
 - (3) Governor's Council on Adolescent Pregnancy;
- (4) State Coordinating Council for Residential Placement of Handicapped Children; AND
 - (5) [Infants and Toddlers Interagency Coordinating Council; and
- (6)] Other multiple agency initiatives for children, youth, and families that are not reserved by law to another agency.

Article - Education

2-107. <u>8-4</u>16.

- (a) The [Office for Children, Youth, and Families] DEPARTMENT shall be the lead agency for supervising and monitoring a statewide, community-based interagency system of comprehensive early intervention services to eligible infants and toddlers, birth through age 2, and their families.
- (b) The interagency system shall include the early intervention services provided or supervised by the State Departments of [Education,] Health and Mental Hygiene, Human Resources, and Juvenile Justice, AND THE OFFICE FOR CHILDREN, YOUTH, AND FAMILIES.
- (c) The interagency system of early intervention services shall be administered in accord with the applicable requirements of Federal Public Law 99-457 and other applicable federal and State laws.
- (d) An interagency coordinating council shall be appointed by the Governor, with the advice and consent of the Senate, and shall:
