- (4) ASSURE THAT THE COMPETITIVE RE ENGINEERING PROCESS IS IMPLEMENTED FAIRLY, AND
- (5) MAKE RECOMMENDATIONS REGARDING COMPETITIVE RE-ENGINEERING TO THE GOVERNOR.

A SERVICE MAY BE PROVIDED THROUGH COMPETITIVE RE-ENGINEERING IF THE HEAD OF THE AGENCY DETERMINES THAT:

- (1) OBJECTIVE PERFORMANCE MEASUREMENTS CAN BE ESTABLISHED;
- (2) THE SERVICE IS OR COULD BE PROVIDED BY THE PRIVATE SECTOR:
- (3) COSTS OR INCREASES IN THE COSTS FOR THE SERVICE COULD BE REDUCED; AND
- (4) COMPETITION FOR THE SERVICE IS IN THE BEST INTEREST OF THE STATE.

- (A) AFTER AN AGENCY MAKES A DETERMINATION UNDER § 18–103 OF THIS TITLE FOR A SERVICE PROVIDED BY A SERVICE UNIT, THE AGENCY SHALL PROVIDES WRITTEN NOTICE OF THE DETERMINATION TO THE SERVICE UNIT THAT PROVIDES THE TARGETED SERVICE.
