(House Bill 259)

AN ACT concerning

Howard County - Alcoholic Beverages (Alcohol Awareness)

Ho. Co. 5-97

FOR the purpose of including Howard County with the jurisdiction that requires that an alcoholic beverages licensee or a person employed in a supervisory capacity shall be certified by an approved alcohol awareness program and shall be present during the hours in which alcohol is sold; *making a certain exception*; clarifying language; and generally relating to alcoholic beverages in Howard County.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages

13-101.

- (c) (2) (i) This paragraph applies only in THE FOLLOWING JURISDICTIONS:
 - 1. HOWARD COUNTY; AND
 - 2. Montgomery County.
- (ii) The licensee or a person who is employed in a supervisory capacity designated by the licensee shall.
- $\underline{I.}$ SHALL be certified by an approved alcohol awareness program; and shall
- <u>2. EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE PROVIDED IN SUBPARAGRAPH (III)</u>
 OF THIS PARAGRAPH, be present during the hours in which alcohol may be sold.
- (III) 1. IN HOWARD COUNTY, THE PERSON CERTIFIED BY AN APPROVED ALCOHOL AWARENESS PROGRAM MAY BE ABSENT FROM THE LICENSED PREMISES FOR A BONA FIDE PERSONAL OR BUSINESS REASON OR AN EMERGENCY, IF THE ABSENCE LASTS FOR NO MORE THAN 2 HOURS.
- 2 THE BOARD OF LICENSE COMMISSIONERS SHALL REQUIRE THE LICENSEE TO KEEP A LOG BOOK ON THE LICENSED PREMISES THAT CONTAINS
