- (2) THE WARDEN OR WARDEN'S DESIGNEE OF AN INSTITUTION UNDER THE JURISDICTION OF THE COMMISSIONER OF CORRECTION.
- (B) (1) ON THE RECOMMENDATION OF A HEALTH CARE PROVIDER, THE CHIEF OFFICER OF A CORRECTIONAL FACILITY MAY AUTHORIZE MEDICAL . TREATMENT OF A JUVENILE INMATE WHEN IN THE JUDGMENT OF THE CHIEF OFFICER THE TREATMENT IS REQUIRED NECESSARY AND A PARENT, GUARDIAN, OR PERSON IN LOCO PARENTIS OF THE JUVENILE IS NOT AVAILABLE ON A TIMELY BASIS TO GIVE THE AUTHORIZATION.
- (2) LIABILITY OF ANY KIND MAY NOT ATTACH TO THE CHIEF OFFICER OF A CORRECTIONAL FACILITY FOR AUTHORIZING IN GOOD FAITH THE MEDICAL MEDICALLY NECESSARY TREATMENT.

 - (e) "Director" means the director of Patuxent Institution.
 - (h) "Institution" means the Patuxent Institution.

- (A) ON THE RECOMMENDATION OF A HEALTH CARE PROVIDER, THE DIRECTOR OF THE INSTITUTION OR THE DESIGNEE OF THE DIRECTOR MAY AUTHORIZE MEDICAL TREATMENT OF A JUVENILE INMATE WHEN IN THE JUDGMENT OF THE DIRECTOR OR THE DESIGNEE THE TREATMENT IS REQUIRED NECESSARY AND A PARENT, GUARDIAN, OR PERSON IN LOCO PARENTIS OF THE JUVENILE IS NOT AVAILABLE ON A TIMELY BASIS TO GIVE THE AUTHORIZATION.
- (B) LIABILITY OF ANY KIND MAY NOT ATTACH TO THE DIRECTOR OR THE DESIGNEE OF THE DIRECTOR FOR AUTHORIZING IN GOOD FAITH THE MEDICAL MEDICALLY NECESSARY TREATMENT.
