CHAPTER 436

(House Bill 384)

AN ACT concerning

**Harford County – Alcoholic Beverages
(Micro-Brewery Licenses)**

FOR the purpose of including Harford County among those jurisdictions in which the Comptroller of Maryland may issue micro-brewery licenses; and generally relating to alcoholic beverages in Harford County.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 2B – Alcoholic Beverages

2-208.

- (a) There is a Class 7 micro-brewery (on- and off-sale) license.
- (b) The license shall be issued:
 - (1) By the State Comptroller;
 - (2) Only in the following jurisdictions:
 - (i) Allegany County;
 - (ii) Baltimore City;
 - (iii) Baltimore County;
 - (iv) The City of Annapolis;
 - (v) Anne Arundel County;
 - (vi) The thirteenth election district of Carroll County;
