WHEREAS, Issues concerning the use of methylphenidate in the State by school age children are of concern to both the public health and educational communities; now, therefore,

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

## Article 41 - Governor - Executive and Administrative Departments

- (A) THERE IS A TASK FORCE TO STUDY THE ABUSES <u>USES</u> OF METHYLPHENIDATE AND OTHER DRUGS ON SCHOOL CHILDREN.
- (B) THE TASK FORCE SHALL BE COMPOSED OF 47 19 MEMBERS APPOINTED AS FOLLOWS:
- (1) ONE MEMBER OF THE HOUSE OF DELEGATES APPOINTED BY THE SPEAKER OF THE HOUSE:
- (2) ONE MEMBER OF THE SENATE OF MARYLAND APPOINTED BY THE PRESIDENT OF THE SENATE:
- (3) ONE MEMBER WHO IS A SCHOOL PSYCHOLOGIST FROM THE STATE BOARD OF EDUCATION APPOINTED BY THE GOVERNOR;
- (4) ONE MEMBER OF THE MARYLAND STATE TEACHERS ASSOCIATION WHO IS A TEACHER APPOINTED BY THE GOVERNOR;
- (5) SEVEN MEMBERS WHO ARE EXPERTS ON ATTENTION DEFICIT HYPERACTIVITY DISORDER FROM THE MEDICAL COMMUNITY APPOINTED BY THE GOVERNOR;
- (6) TWO MEMBERS WHO ARE REGISTERED NURSES EMPLOYED AS SCHOOL NURSES APPOINTED BY THE GOVERNOR;
- (7) ONE MEMBER WHO IS A LICENSED PHYSICIAN APPOINTED BY THE STATE BOARD OF PHYSICIAN QUALITY ASSURANCE;
- (8) ONE MEMBER WHO IS A LICENSED PSYCHOLOGIST APPOINTED BY THE STATE BOARD OF EXAMINERS OF PSYCHOLOGISTS;
- (9) ONE MEMBER WHO IS A PARENT OF A CHILD ON METHYLPHENIDATE APPOINTED BY THE GOVERNOR; AND
- (10) ONE MEMBER WHO IS A MEMBER OF CHILDREN AND ADULTS WITH ATTENTION DEFICIT DISORDER (CHADD) APPOINTED BY THE GOVERNOR; AND

## (11) TWO MEMBERS WHO ARE SPECIAL EDUCATION TEACHERS.

- (C) THE GOVERNOR SHALL DESIGNATE THE CHAIRMAN OF THE TASK FORCE.
- (D) THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION AND THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND MENTAL HYGIENE JOINTLY SHALL PROVIDE STAFF FOR THE TASK FORCE.
