- (12) real property that is:
- (i) owned by the Rosa Ponselle Charitable Foundation, Incorporated, known as "Villa Pace"; and
 - (ii) not exempt under this article; [and]
- (13) agricultural land, not including any improvements, that is located in an agricultural preservation district; AND
- (14) REAL PROPERTY THAT IS OWNED BY HAREWOOD PARK COMMUNITY LEAGUE, INC.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1997.

(House Bill 1226)
