(House Bill 1336)

AN ACT concerning

Education – Maryland Adult External High School Program – Funding

FOR the purpose of requiring the ~~State Department of Education to maintain the funding of the Maryland Adult External High School Program at a certain level for a certain time period~~ Governor to include minimum amounts of funds in the annual budget bill for the Maryland Adult External High School Program; clarifying the establishment and requirements of, as well as the recognition of the need for, the Maryland Adult External High School Program; requiring the State Board of Education to evaluate the Program and submit a certain report to the General Assembly before a certain date; providing for the termination of this Act; and generally relating to adult education in the State.
