SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

## Article 88A - Department of Human Resources

## 44A.

- (a) In this subtitle the following terms have the meanings indicated.
- (b) "Cooperative living project" means a welfare demonstration project providing a shared living arrangement as an alternative to cash assistance.
  - (c) "Department" means the Department of Human Resources.
  - (d) "FIP" means Family Investment Program.
  - (e) "Grant diversion" means the payment of businesses for hiring recipients.
- (f) "Individualized case-management project" means a welfare demonstration project providing coordination and intensive case management of FIP and related benefits and services.
- (g) "Local department" means a local department of social services in a county or in Baltimore City created or continued under the provisions of § 13 of this article.
