~~(3) ON OR BEFORE JULY 1, 1998, AND EACH JULY 1 THEREAFTER, EACH INSTITUTION OF HIGHER EDUCATION SHALL COMPILE AND SUBMIT A REPORT, SUBJECT TO § 2-1312 OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE, TO THE JOINT COMMITTEE ON WELFARE REFORM DETAILING ITS ACTIVITIES UNDER THE PROGRAM DEVELOPED AND IMPLEMENTED UNDER PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION IN IDENTIFYING AND PROVIDING VOLUNTEERS FROM ITS STUDENT BODY STUDENTS VOLUNTEERING TO TUTOR, MENTOR, AND PROVIDE ANY OTHER SERVICES TO FIP RECIPIENTS FOR PURPOSES OF ASSISTING FIP RECIPIENTS IN OBTAINING EMPLOYMENT AND OR MEETING ANY OTHER FIP REQUIREMENTS UNDER THIS SUBTITLE.~~

(D) (1) IN ADDITION TO THE PROVISIONS OF § 53(C) OF THIS SUBTITLE, THE MARYLAND HIGHER EDUCATION COMMISSION, IN COOPERATION WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN RESOURCES, SHALL:

(i) IDENTIFY AND PROMOTE AT INSTITUTIONS OF HIGHER EDUCATION EXISTING EFFORTS THAT TO PROVIDE ASSISTANCE TO FIP RECIPIENTS; AND

(ii) COORDINATE EFFORTS AMONG INSTITUTIONS OF HIGHER EDUCATION TO ENCOURAGE AND IDENTIFY STUDENT VOLUNTEERS TO HELP PROVIDE TO FIP RECIPIENTS EDUCATIONAL AND EMPLOYMENT-RELATED SERVICES, SUCH AS LITERACY TRAINING, RESUME WRITING, AND JOB INTERVIEWING SKILLS.

(2) AN INSTITUTION OF HIGHER EDUCATION SHALL:

(i) MEET WITH THE LOCAL DEPARTMENT ABOUT DEVELOPING SERVICES FOR FAMILY INVESTMENT PROGRAM FIP RECIPIENTS IN THE JURISDICTION IN WHICH THE INSTITUTION IS LOCATED; AND

(ii) ADVISE THE LOCAL DEPARTMENT OF THE SERVICES AVAILABLE FOR FIP RECIPIENTS; RECIPIENTS; AND

(iii) BY SEPTEMBER 15 OF EACH YEAR, PROVIDE TO THE MARYLAND HIGHER EDUCATION COMMISSION, A REPORT ON EFFORTS TO ENCOURAGE AND IDENTIFY STUDENT VOLUNTEERS AND IDENTIFY SERVICES PROVIDED UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SUBSECTION.

(3) BY DECEMBER 1, 1997 AND DECEMBER 1, 1998, RESPECTIVELY OF EACH YEAR, THE MARYLAND HIGHER EDUCATION COMMISSION SHALL SUBMIT A REPORT, SUBJECT TO § 2-1312 OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE, TO THE JOINT COMMITTEE ON WELFARE REFORM REGARDING THE SERVICES PROVIDED UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SUBSECTION.
