- (ii) provides for individual death benefits not exceeding \$400 per year or disability benefits not exceeding \$350 per year or both;
  - (iii) does not issue benefit certificates; and
  - (iv) has a membership of not more than 1,000 individuals.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 1997.
