(ii) a foreign jurisdiction that has ENACTED A LAW OR established procedures for issuance and enforcement of support orders which are substantially similar to the procedures under this subtitle, THE UNIFORM RECIPROCAL ENFORCEMENT OF SUPPORT ACT, OR THE REVISED UNIFORM RECIPROCAL ENFORCEMENT OF SUPPORT ACT.

## Part II. Jurisdiction.

## SUBPART A. EXTENDED PERSONAL JURISDICTION.

10-304. BASES FOR JURISDICTION OVER NONRESIDENT.

IN A PROCEEDING TO ESTABLISH, ENFORCE, OR MODIFY A SUPPORT ORDER OR TO DETERMINE PARENTAGE, A TRIBUNAL OF THIS STATE MAY EXERCISE PERSONAL JURISDICTION OVER A NONRESIDENT INDIVIDUAL OR THE INDIVIDUAL'S GUARDIAN OR CONSERVATOR IF:

- (1) THE INDIVIDUAL IS PERSONALLY SERVED WITHIN THIS STATE;
- (2) THE INDIVIDUAL SUBMITS TO THE JURISDICTION OF THIS STATE BY CONSENT, BY ENTERING A GENERAL APPEARANCE, OR BY FILING A RESPONSIVE DOCUMENT HAVING THE EFFECT OF WAIVING ANY CONTEST TO PERSONAL JURISDICTION;
  - (3) THE INDIVIDUAL RESIDED WITH THE CHILD IN THIS STATE:
- (4) (3) THE INDIVIDUAL RESIDED IN THIS STATE AND PROVIDED PRENATAL EXPENSES OR SUPPORT FOR THE CHILD:
- (5) (4) THE CHILD RESIDES IN THIS STATE AS RESULT OF THE ACTS OR DIRECTIVES OF THE INDIVIDUAL:
- (6) (5) THE INDIVIDUAL ENGAGED IN SEXUAL INTERCOURSE IN THIS STATE—AND THE CHILD MAY HAVE BEEN CONCEIVED BY THAT ACT—OF INTERCOURSE IN THIS STATE; OR
- (7) (6) THERE IS ANY OTHER BASIS CONSISTENT WITH THE CONSTITUTIONS OF THIS STATE AND THE UNITED STATES FOR THE EXERCISE OF PERSONAL JURISDICTION.
- 10-305. PROCEDURE WHEN EXERCISING JURISDICTION OVER NONRESIDENT.

A TRIBUNAL OF THIS STATE EXERCISING PERSONAL JURISDICTION OVER A NONRESIDENT UNDER § 10–304 OF THIS SUBTITLE MAY APPLY § 10–328 OF THIS SUBTITLE (SPECIAL RULES OF EVIDENCE AND PROCEDURE) TO RECEIVE EVIDENCE FROM ANOTHER STATE, AND § 10–330 OF THIS SUBTITLE (ASSISTANCE WITH DISCOVERY) TO OBTAIN DISCOVERY THROUGH A TRIBUNAL OF ANOTHER STATE. IN ALL OTHER RESPECTS, PARTS III THROUGH VII OF THIS SUBTITLE DO NOT APPLY AND THE TRIBUNAL SHALL APPLY THE PROCEDURAL AND SUBSTANTIVE LAW OF THIS STATE, INCLUDING THE RULES ON CHOICE OF LAW OTHER THAN THOSE ESTABLISHED BY THIS SUBTITLE.
