(Senate Bill 642)

AN ACT concerning

Condominiums - Parking for the Handicapped - Council of Unit Owners

FOR the purpose of providing that the declaration of a condominium does not have to be amended in order for the council of unit owners to designate parking for the handicapped; authorizing the council of unit owners of a condominium to designate parking for the handicapped, notwithstanding any provision in the declaration, bylaws, or rules and regulations; and generally relating to the designation of parking for the handicapped by the council of unit owners of a condominium.
