PHARMACIST HAS A DUTY TO EXERCISE INDEPENDENT PROFESSIONAL JUDGMENT IN DECIDING WHETHER OR NOT TO DISPENSE OR REFILL A PRESCRIPTION.

(B) IN REFUSING TO DISPENSE OR REFILL A PRESCRIPTION, THE DECISION OF THE PHARMACIST SHALL NOT BE ARBITRARY BUT SHALL BE BASED ON PROFESSIONAL EXPERIENCE, KNOWLEDGE, OR AVAILABLE REFERENCE MATERIALS.

12-501.

- (A) A PHARMACIST MAY REFUSE TO DISPENSE OR REFILL A PRESCRIPTION IF THE DECISION IS BASED ON PROFESSIONAL JUDGEMENT, EXPERIENCE, KNOWLEDGE, OR AVAILABLE REFERENCE MATERIALS.
- (B) (1) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION, IF A PHARMACIST REFUSES TO DISPENSE OR REFILL A PRESCRIPTION, THE PHARMACIST SHALL, TO THE EXTENT PRACTICABLE, NOTIFY THE AUTHORIZED PRESCRIBER THAT THE PRESCRIPTION OR REFILL WAS REFUSED WITHIN 12 HOURS AFTER THE REFUSAL.
- (2) PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION DOES NOT APPLY IF A PHARMACIST IS UNABLE TO DETERMINE THE NAME OF THE AUTHORIZED PRESCRIBER 12–502.
- (a) {In the operation of a pharmacy, only} ONLY a licensed pharmacist or an individual engaging in a [clinical pharmacy training] PROFESSIONAL EXPERIENCE program and acting under the direct supervision of a licensed pharmacist may provide information to the public OR A HEALTH CARE PRACTITIONER concerning PRESCRIPTION OR NONPRESCRIPTION drugs; OR [medicines, and] devices, OR DIAGNOSTICS including information as to their therapeutic values, potential side effects, and use in the treatment and prevention of diseases.
- (b) [While on the premises of a pharmacy, a] A licensed pharmacist shall give [an individual] A PATIENT who requests, in person or by telephone, the current price of a prescription drug, <u>OR DEVICE</u>, <u>OR DIAGNOSTIC</u> that the pharmacy offers for sale to the public.

[12-503.

- (a) The Board shall specify the minimum professional and technical equipment and sanitary appliances that are necessary in a pharmacy:
 - (1) To prepare and dispense prescriptions properly; and
 - (2) Otherwise to operate a pharmacy.
 - (b) Each pharmacy shall be:
- (1) Equipped with the minimum equipment and appliances specified by the Board under this section; and
 - (2) Kept in a clean and orderly manner.
