AN ACT concerning

Property Tax Credit Tax Credits - Businesses That Create New Jobs

FOR the purpose of authorizing the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore City or the governing body of a county or municipal corporation to grant, by law, a property tax credit against the county or municipal corporation property tax imposed on certain real property and personal property; providing for the eligibility criteria for the property tax credit including requirements for the construction, expansion, or lease of a certain minimum number of square feet on which the business entity conducts its business and the creation of a certain minimum number of new permanent full-time positions; prohibiting the property tax credit to be granted under certain circumstances; providing for the computation of the property tax credit; requiring a certain notification; requiring certain lessors to reduce a certain liability of certain lessees; authorizing requiring the governing body of the county or municipal corporation to provide, by law, for certain other provisions to implement the property tax credit; requiring the State to reimburse a county or municipal corporation for certain amounts in a certain manner granting a State tax credit against the individual or corporate income tax, insurance premium tax, financial institution franchise tax, or the public service franchise tax, under certain conditions; providing for the computation of certain State tax credits; prohibiting the application of a certain State tax credit more than once; providing for the carryover of certain excess State tax credits; requiring the adoption of certain regulations; defining certain terms; and generally relating to a property tax credit for certain property owned or leased by providing for the application and termination of this Act; and generally relating to certain tax credits for certain businesses that create new jobs.
