PART V. OFFICE OF LEGISLATIVE INFORMATION SYSTEMS.

2-1228. DEFINITIONS.

(A) IN THIS PART V THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS INDICATED.

(B) "DIRECTOR" MEANS THE DIRECTOR OF THE OFFICE.

(C) "OFFICE" MEANS THE OFFICE OF LEGISLATIVE INFORMATION SYSTEMS.

2-1229. OFFICE ESTABLISHED.

THERE IS AN OFFICE OF LEGISLATIVE INFORMATION SYSTEMS IN THE DEPARTMENT.

2-1230. DIRECTOR.

(A) THE HEAD OF THE OFFICE IS THE DIRECTOR, WHO SHALL BE APPOINTED BY THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR, SUBJECT TO THE APPROVAL OF THE PRESIDENT AND THE SPEAKER.

(B) THE DIRECTOR SERVES WITHOUT A FIXED TERM AND MAY BE REMOVED BY THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR, SUBJECT TO THE APPROVAL OF THE PRESIDENT AND THE SPEAKER.

(C) THE DIRECTOR IS ENTITLED TO THE SALARY PROVIDED IN THE STATE BUDGET.

2-1231. GENERAL AUTHORITY.

(A) SUBJECT TO THE POLICIES AND DIRECTIVES OF THE PRESIDENT AND THE SPEAKER AND THE OVERALL SUPERVISION AND CONTROL OF THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR, THE DIRECTOR SHALL OVERSEE THE OPERATION OF THE OFFICE.

(B) THE DIRECTOR SHALL SERVE IN A NONPARTISAN CAPACITY AND CONDUCT THE AFFAIRS OF THE OFFICE IN A NONPARTISAN MANNER.

2-1232. DUTIES.

IN ADDITION TO ANY OTHER DUTIES SET FORTH ELSEWHERE, THE OFFICE SHALL:

(1) DEVELOP, COORDINATE, SUPPORT, AND MAINTAIN COMPUTER SERVICES AND AUTOMATED DATA PROCESSING AND INFORMATION SYSTEMS FOR THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY AND THE DEPARTMENT;

(2) PROVIDE TRAINING FOR EMPLOYEES OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY AND THE DEPARTMENT WHO USE THE INFORMATION SYSTEMS;

(3) PLAN FOR THE FUTURE INFORMATION SYSTEMS NEEDS OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY, ITS STAFF, AND THE DEPARTMENT;
