- (3) AGENTS OR BROKERS WHO HOLD ONLY A RESTRICTED CERTIFICATE OF QUALIFICATION IN ANY OF THE FOLLOWING TYPES OF INSURANCE:
- (I) CREDIT LIFE, CREDIT ACCIDENT, OR CREDIT HEALTH INSURANCE;
- $_{\mbox{(II)}}$ TRAVEL TICKET POLICIES OF LIFE, ACCIDENT, OR BAGGAGE INSURANCE; OR
- (III) ANY-OTHER TYPE OF INSURANCE DESIGNATED BY THE COMMISSIONER.
- (C) THE COMMISSIONER SHALL REVIEW ALL CONTINUING EDUCATION COURSES SUBMITTED AND APPROVE OR DISAPPROVE COURSES ON AFTER RECEIVING THE RECOMMENDATION OF THE APPROPRIATE ADVISORY BOARD APPOINTED UNDER § 10-110 OF THIS SUBTITLE.
- (D) THE COMMISSIONER MAY ADOPT REGULATIONS TO CARRY OUT THIS SECTION.

- (A) ON OR BEFORE SEPTEMBER 30 OF THE RENEWAL YEAR, A PERSON WHOSE CERTIFICATE OF QUALIFICATION HAS EXPIRED MAY REINSTATE THE EXPIRED CERTIFICATE OF OUALIFICATION BY:
- (1) FILING WITH THE COMMISSIONER THE APPROPRIATE REINSTATEMENT APPLICATION;
- (2) PAYING TO THE COMMISSIONER THE APPLICABLE REINSTATEMENT FEE REQUIRED UNDER SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION; AND
- (3) SUBMITTING PROOF OF COMPLETION OF THE CONTINUING EDUCATION REQUIREMENTS IN § 10–116 OF THIS SUBTITLE.
- (B) $(\underline{1})$ THE FEE FOR A REINSTATEMENT UNDER THIS SECTION SHALL BE TWICE:
- (I) THE AMOUNT CHARGED FOR A FULL RENEWAL PERIOD FOR THE TYPE OF CERTIFICATE OF QUALIFICATION HELD BY THE PERSON SEEKING THE REINSTATEMENT; AND
- (II) 1. \$25 FOR REINSTATEMENT DURING THE PERIOD FROM JULY 1 THROUGH JULY 31;
- 2. \$50 FOR REINSTATEMENT DURING THE PERIOD FROM AUGUST 1 THROUGH AUGUST 31; AND
- 3. \$75 FOR REINSTATEMENT DURING THE PERIOD FROM SEPTEMBER 1 THROUGH SEPTEMBER 30.
- (2) THE COMMISSIONER MAY LIMIT THE REINSTATEMENT FEE TO THE AMOUNT OF THE RENEWAL FEE IN CASES WHERE THE REINSTATEMENT APPLICANT
