

4. Election district 12, precincts 1 through 14.

(viii) The 27th alcoholic beverages district at all times shall be coterminous with the 27th legislative district of Prince George's County, as determined by the Prince George's County Board of Supervisors of Elections. As of April 7, 1994, the 27th alcoholic beverages district consisted of:

1. Election district 3, precincts 1 and 3;
2. Election district 4, precinct 1;
3. Election district 5, precincts 1, 3, and 4;
4. Election district 8, precinct 1;
5. Election district 9, precincts 1, 4, 6, 7, 8, and 9;
6. Election district 11, precincts 1 and 2; and
7. Election district 15, precincts 1 through 3.

(2) The Prince George's County Board of License Commissioners may approve the issuance or transfer of a license into the boundaries of the 13th (that portion located within the County), 21st, 22nd, 23rd, 24th, 25th, 26th, or 27th alcoholic beverages district provided any off-sale privileges of the license are permanently waived as long as the license remains within the boundaries of the district.
